Post Graduate Government College for Girls, Sector 11, Chandigarh is a leading institution of the northern region that has been imparting quality education for more than six decades. Established in 1956 the college continues to maintain a glorious legacy of academic excellence in the disciplines of humanities, sciences, commerce and computer application both at the under-graduate and post-graduate level. The college has illustrious alumni who bring laurels with their achievements in diverse fields like bureaucracy, academics and even the film industry. During the coronavirus pandemic, the teaching, non-teaching and administrative staff worked round the clock to make the transition from offline to online mode seamless for the students. As we resumed classroom teaching after a hiatus of two years, we diligently ensured the conduct of all curricular and co-curricular activities involving a creative interaction between the students and the faculty.

## **COLLEGE LIBRARY**

The College Library is fully computerized with LIBSYS software and has air-conditioned Reading Hall, Circulation Section, Reference Section, Periodical Section and Research Faculty Centre.

Free Internet facility is available in the library for the students. INFLIBNET N-List facility is provided to access e-journals and e-books to the faculty, post graduate students and research scholars. There is a faculty research centre equipped with computers with internet access for teachers engaged in research work. A Braille corner is set up for the visually challenged students. The library is equipped with CCTVs.

The library has a collection of more than **96328 books, 86 magazines, 15 newspapers and 38 Journals**. Text-books are also issued to needy and meritorious students for the entire academic session. Free books and stationery worth Rs. 80,000/- has been distributed among 308 SC/ST students.

PGGCG-11 is the first College in Chandigarh to introduce RFID system in the library. It simplifies the process of selfcheck-in and check-out of books. This system is also anti-theft.

An LCD is also displayed in the library where recent activities of the library, new arrivals and current affairs are exhibited regularly.

The orientation programme for the new students of the college was organized in the library from 07.03.2022 to 16.03.2022. Approximately 2000 students visited the library where library rules, library services, library competitions, circulation of library books and various library sections were explained to them. Protocols to be followed during the pandemic while entering the library were also explained.

The library has also got institutional membership of National Digital Library of India (NDLI) for all faculty members and students. NDLI is a platform for all the learners with educational

materials from primary to postgraduate levels across multiple subject domains. All first-year students of the college are also enrolled for this membership.

The library also has an Alumni Desk where old students of the college are registered in the Alumni Association- Nostalgia.

The library also maintains a record of the results of all the courses and issues Character Certificates and old Degrees to the college students.

A Library blog is also maintained as “PGGCG11LIBRARY” where library activities are uploaded and updated regularly. Library blog also provide the access to open resources by providing links. Honours Classes results, Syllabus, Old Question papers etc are also available on the library blog.

**Web-OPAC** service was provided to the users 24\*7 over the internet through the <https://117.239.7.66:8080/jopacv11> by which one can check the availability of the books in the library.

## **COLLEGE MAGAZINE**

*Abha*, the college magazine, showcases in pictorial form the achievements of the college and also provides a forum for the students to express their creativity on a wide range of issues in English, Hindi and Punjabi.

## **ORIENTATION ASSEMBLY**

To acquaint new students with the college environment an orientation assembly is organised at the start of every academic session. The Principal, Prof. Anita Kaushal welcomes the students and highlights the curricular and co-curricular aspects as well as the rules and regulations of the college. Information is also imparted regarding time-tables, exams, college societies, library and scholarships available, so that the transition from school to college is smooth. This year the orientation was held on **3<sup>rd</sup> March, 2022** in the college grounds.

## TUTORIAL MEET

Tutorial meets are organised twice a month on alternative Saturdays. Each tutor is assigned 25-35 students to familiarise them with the general discipline, rules and regulations. The students are also apprised of the Prevention of Ragging Committee and Sexual Harassment Complaint Centre.
