However, the applicant cannot claim the seat as his/her right. If the applicant does not opt for hostel in the form then he/she cannot claim the hostel seat at the time of admission. Students seeking admission to the hostel have to apply in advance as per instructions given below:

- Candidates will apply online at [www.dhe.chd.gov.in](http://www.dhe.chd.gov.in).
- Students who are seeking hostel accommodation are required to submit Negative RT-PCR report (not more than 72 hours old) before occupying hostel accommodation (As per Guidelines issued by Chandigarh Administration).
- **All students old and new seeking hostel accommodation are required to fill in the hostel column as YES while filling admission form online.**
- Mere submission of application form does not ensure admission.
- Admission is strictly on merit and on the availability of seats.
- Hostel seat is allotted for one academic year only.
- Admission will have to be sought afresh in every academic session.
- Under graduate students from the final year of various streams cannot reserve a seat for the Post Graduate courses.
- A seat can be denied to the old resident if her conduct, attendance and result of the mid semester and annual examinations have not been up to the mark.
