-Admission Guidelines All foreign students shall obtain Eligibility Certificate from Deputy Registrar (General) Panjab University, in all cases and the admission of the foreign students College /Teaching Departments would be governed by the guidelines issued by the Dean ,Foreign Students. The eligibility form should

be accompanied by forwarding letter from the Principal of the college/ Chairperson of the Teaching Department indicating the reason for denying the admission to the candidate. After obtaining the Eligibility Certificate, the candidate should submit the same to College/ Department where he/ she is seeking admission.

Checking of Documents for Foreign Students:

- Mere submission of application form does not ensure admission.




