

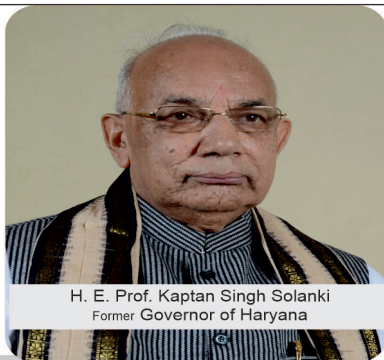
- ◆ **Academics:** Guided by our dedicated staff, we secure 100 % results in the majority of the disciplines.

Wall Magazines

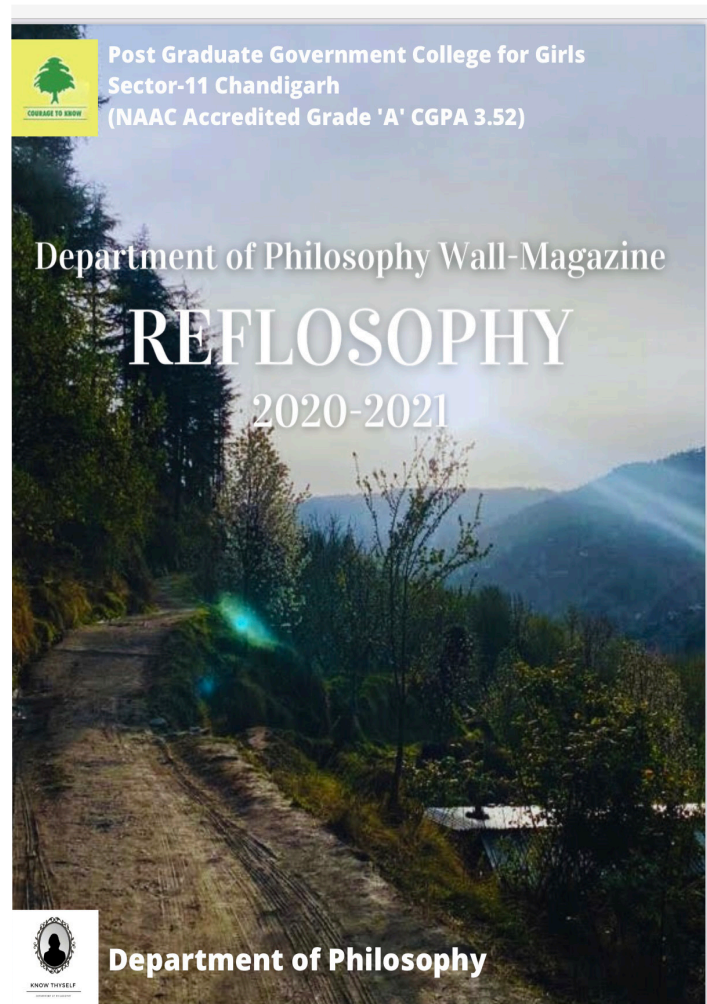
The students of various departments of PGGCG-11 bring out wall magazines that provide a forum to communicate ideas, opinions, and information.

All foreign students shall obtain Eligibility Certificate from Deputy Registrar (General) Panjab University, in all cases and the admission of the foreign students College /Teaching Departments would be governed by the guidelines issued by the Dean ,Foreign Students. The eligibility form should be accompanied by forwarding letter from the Principal of the college/ Chairperson of the Teaching Department indicating the reason for denying the admission to the candidate. After obtaining the Eligibility Certificate, the candidate should submit the same to College/ Department where he/ she is seeking admission.

 - ◆ Telephone Number/Mobile Number of the applicant and the parents (Applicant will receive acknowledgement of the filled Online Form through sms on her mobile number)
 - ◆ Complete particulars of local Guardian in case of Hostel applicant.
 - ◆ Applicant's Bank Name, Account Number, IFSC Code of Branch and Aadhar card number (If allotted)
3. An applicant can apply online only through the DHE website www.dhe.chd.gov.in . There is no offline mode for submission of application form.
4. Candidate will be asked to select her college (select Post Graduate Government College for Girls, Sec-11, Chandigarh)
5. **Each section of the online application form should be completed carefully.**
6. You are required to upload the marksheets of results of all previous semesters' examinations and provide the consolidated results in the relevant column in admission form.
7. The Admission form has separate columns for mother's name and father's name which should be mentioned in all the records. However, in case the applicant does not wish to declare the name of mother or father, she may mention name of either father or mother.
8. Give the full form of Board/ University from which the last examination has been cleared. Example : Punjab School Education Board instead of PSEB

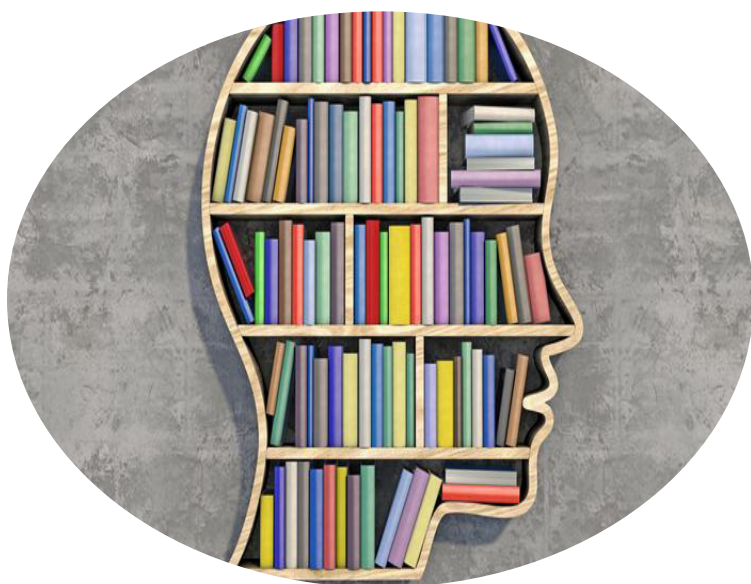

Hostel Admission Guidelines

Due to COVID-19 situation hostel seat will be given as per the Guidelines/SOPs issued by the Government of India and Chandigarh Administration from time to time and on merit.

Students seeking admission to the hostel have to apply in advance as per instructions given below:

- Candidates will apply online at www.dhe.chd.gov.in.
- All students old and new seeking hostel accommodation are required to fill in the hostel column as YES while filling admission form online.
- Students who are seeking hostel accommodation are required to submit **Negative RT-PCR report** (not more than 72 hours old) and also the certificates of double vaccination at the time of hostel admission (As per Guidelines issued by Chandigarh Administration).
- All the rules and regulations pertaining to hostel admission and allotment of hostel rooms will be displayed on college website when offline/physical classes start.
- Mere submission of application form does not ensure admission.
- Admission is strictly on merit and on the availability of seats.
- Hostel seat is allotted for one academic year only.
- Admission will have to be sought afresh in every academic session.
- Under graduate students from the final year of various streams cannot reserve a seat for the Post Graduate courses.
- A seat can be denied to the old resident if her conduct, attendance and result of the mid semester and annual examinations have not been up to the mark.

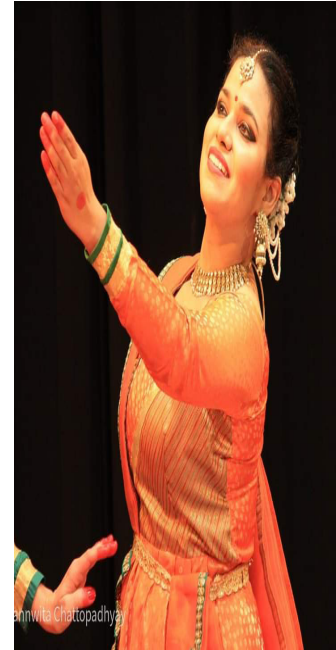

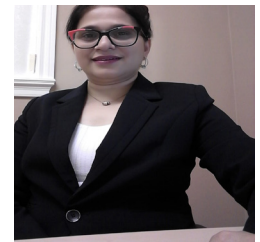

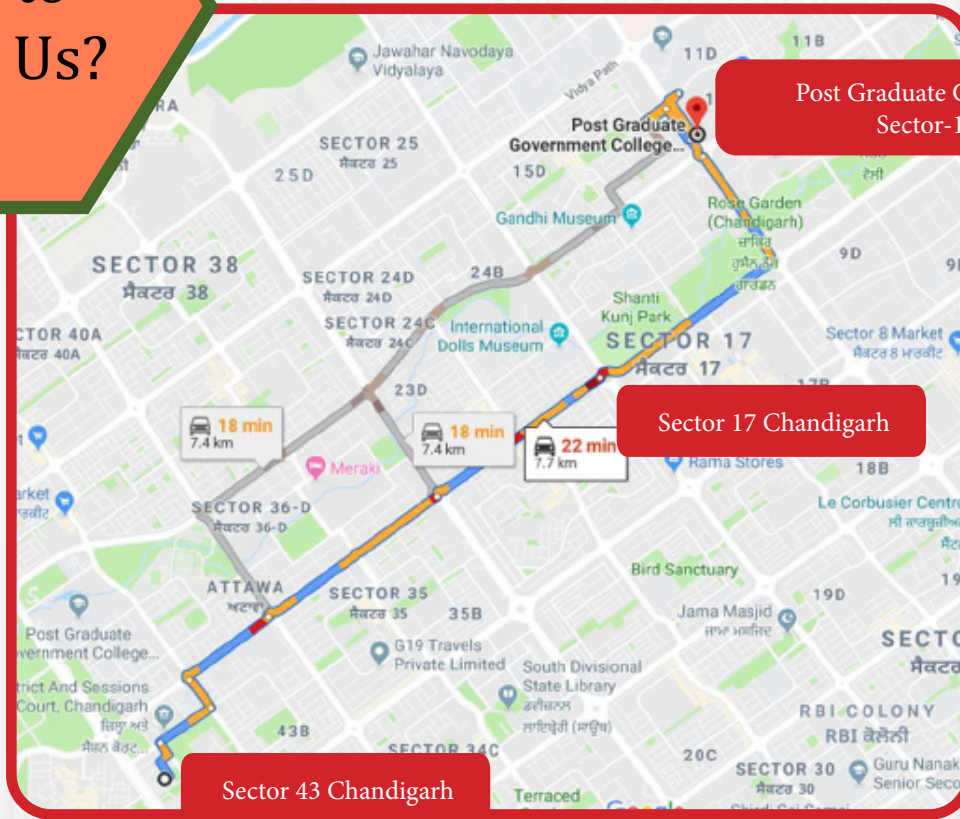
