General Instructions:-

- All bonafide students of the colleges affiliated to PU and its constituent colleges can participate.
- Each college can send only one entry per category.
- Each student shall mention the following details and attach a photo of the college identity card with photograph and send it via **Whatsapp** or **Email** along with Name, Father's Name, Class, Roll No., College Name and Photo ID.
- Last date for submitting the entries is **26-07-2020**.
- Students of the host college could participate but not compete in the competition.
- Result will be declared on **31-07-2020** on the college website geg11.ac.in
- The winners and participants will be awarded the E-certificates.

Rules for competition:-

- Time for presentation is upto 3 minutes. (that shall not include the introduction- Name & College)
- Only single participant can participate.
- Vocal participants can sing with/without instruments.
- No accompanist is allowed. However participant can sing along with harmonium/any folk instrument played by him/her.
- For folk instrumental category, the participant can choose any folk instrument including Tumbi, Dhol, Chimta, Sarangi, Algoza, etc.
- Classical dhun can be played on Sitar, Violin, Israj, Flute etc.
- Videos must be clear and audible.
