### Constitution Day

Prof. Anita Kaushal, Principal of the college, teaching and non-teaching staff of the college read out the Preamble to the Constitution at 11 AM. A Special Talk on 'Relevance of Fundamental Duties' was organized on the occasion. Prof. Shruti Bedi, University Institute of Legal Studies, Panjab University, Chandigarh was the key-note speaker.

Highlighting the significance of Constitution, Principal Prof. Anita Kaushal observed that it is a guiding force for the citizens, and has stood the test of time. Prof. Shruti Bedi initiated her discourse by highlighting that the Indian Constitution is the longest surviving Constitution in the post-colonial world. The main focus of her Talk was on 'Relevance of Fundamental Duties'. 
