Kala-Srijan: The Creative Hand Society had organized a “Demonstration cum Interactive Session Water Colour Painting Workshop” in the department of Fine Arts on **21<sup>st</sup> February, 2019**. More than 100 students had participated in the workshop. Mr. Sikander Singh, a specialist in water colour had demonstrated landscape, portrait, flowers, etc. He stressed that while doing in water colour, maintaining freshness of the colour is very important. He also demonstrated his own techniques to show the translucent effect of water colour. The whole demonstration was conducted in three sessions: Portrait demonstration, Landscape demonstration and interactive session with students. More than 70 students attempted to do in the same method in water colour as demonstrated by the artist. Students had taken part with all their energy and came out with excellent results.
