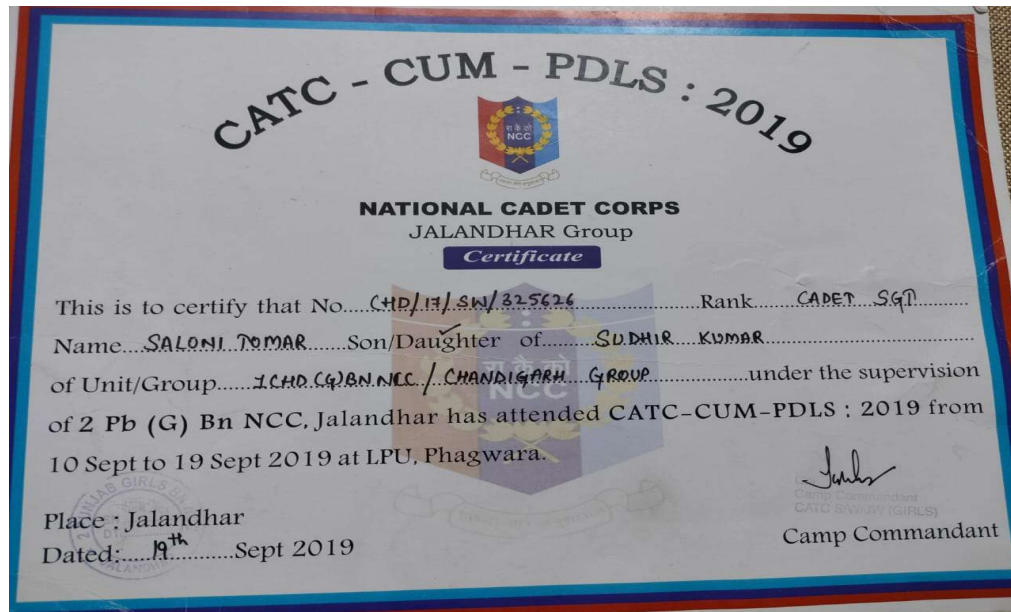

Breast Cancer Awareness Rally

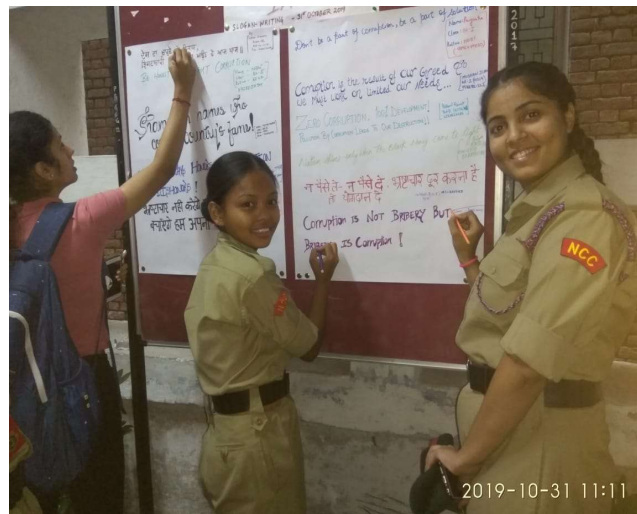
