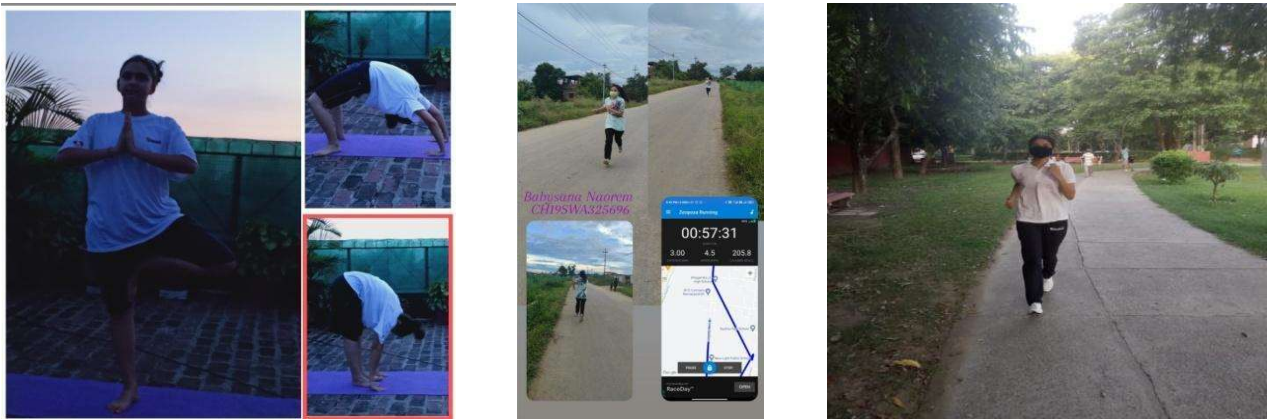

## Fit India Freedom Run

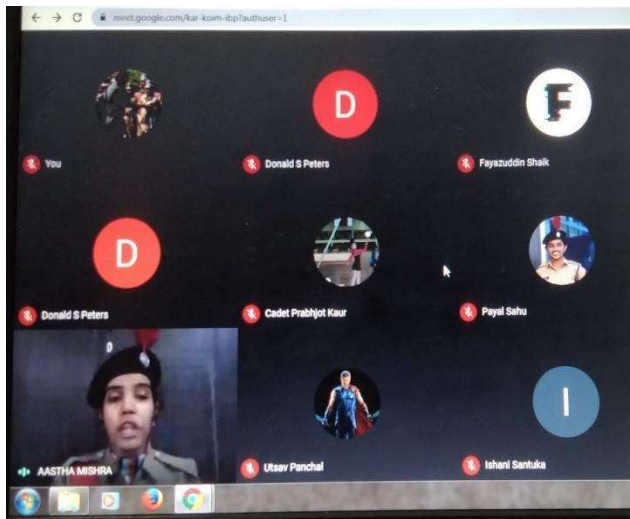
