Alumni Talk

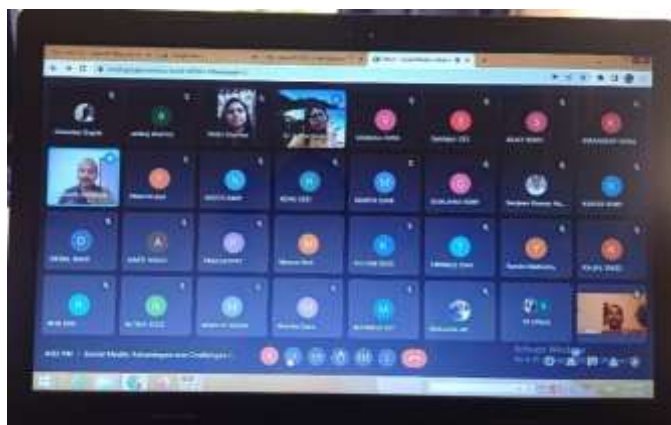
