ABOUT THE COLLEGE:

P.G. Govt. College for Girls, sector-11, Chandigarh was established in the year 1956. The college motto "COURAGE TO KNOW" inspires the students to strive and seek the best in thought, word and deed. The college is on a sprawling 35 acres area out of which total constructed area accounts for 58116sq.mt. The college has 15 lush green lawns and gardens: the Botanical Garden, the Herbal Garden and the Solace Garden. It also has to its credit ample spacious playgrounds, indoor Badminton Court and a State of the art Gymnasium Hall. The college has Smart Classrooms, well equipped science, computer and language laboratories, seminar and conference room, research centre, open air stage and auditorium too.
