Q.1 The teacher is punctual

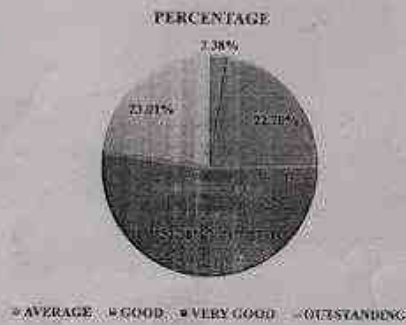

Q.2 I am satisfied with style of presentation of the teacher

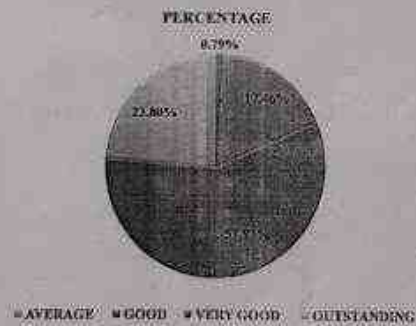

Q.3 Understanding of subject matter

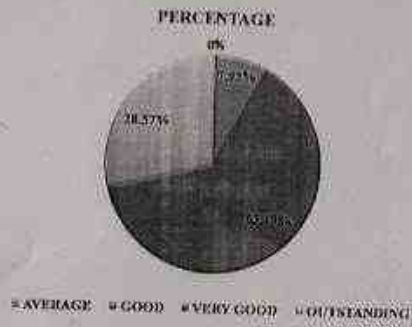

Q.4 The teacher is very much cooperative in class

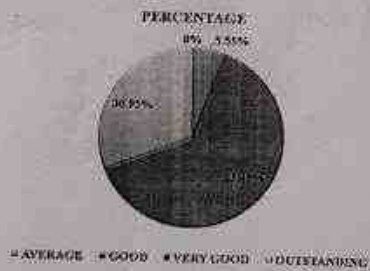

Q.5 Teacher makes the subject/learning more interesting.

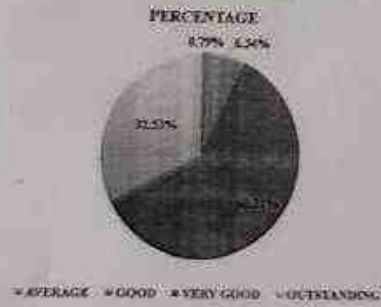

Q.6 The teacher encourages the student to ask question.

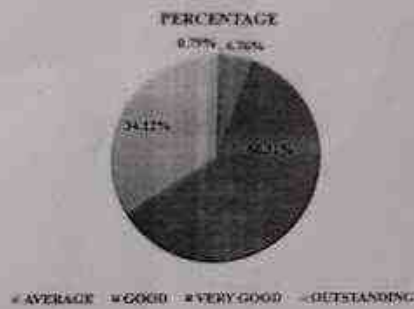

Q.7 Interest/ motivation is generated by the teacher

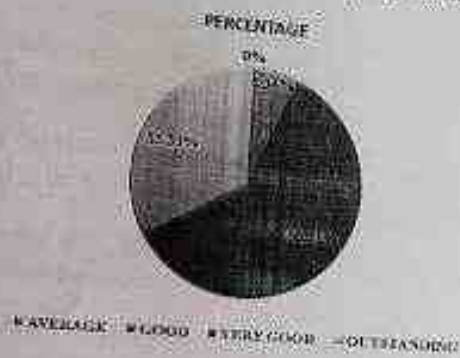

Q.8 Overall rating about the teacher

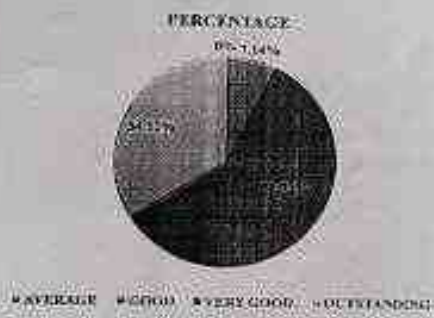

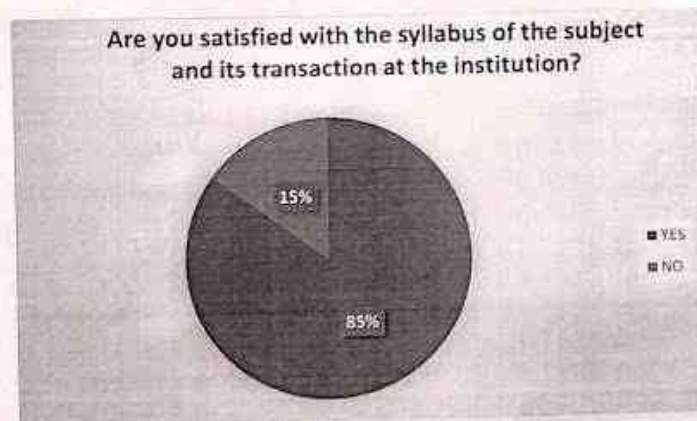

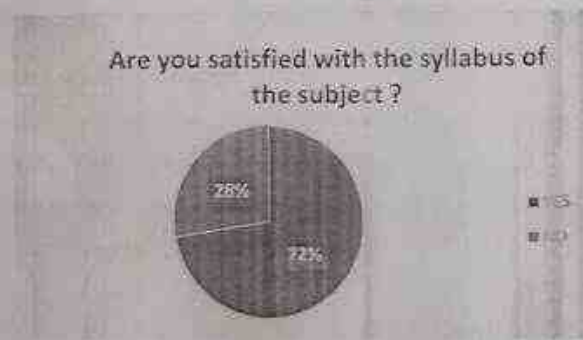

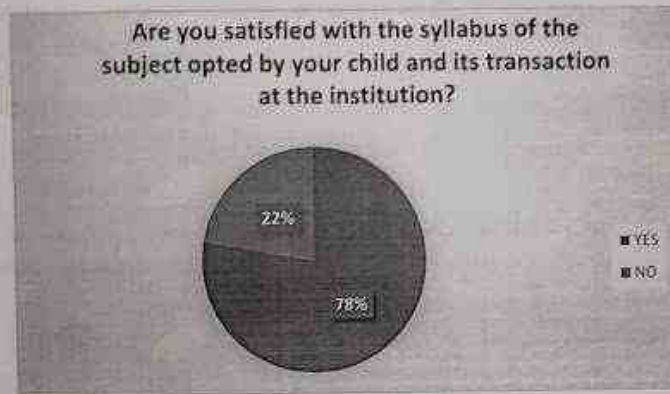

Action Taken Report on the basis of Students' Feedback (2017-18)

The survey included 126 responses from students of UG&PG classes including all the streams viz. B.A, B.Sc., M.A, M.Sc., B.Com, B.C.A. About 75.39% of the students responded that the teachers are punctual and follows the time table properly.

The Principal encouraged the faculty to be aware of the latest methodology towards e-teaching skills and prepare study material in the form of demonstrative PPTs, Video Lectures and recordings.

To improve the understanding about the subject and its latest advances, journals were subscribed for the reference of both faculty and students.

Only 63% students stated that teachers were cooperative in the class. The Principal advised the faculty members to be polite and cooperative with students and provide them counselling whenever required.

IQAC committee directed all the faculty members to prepare weekly planner so as to make the students aware about the syllabus to be covered in succeeding weeks.

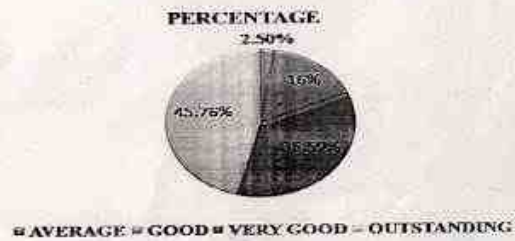

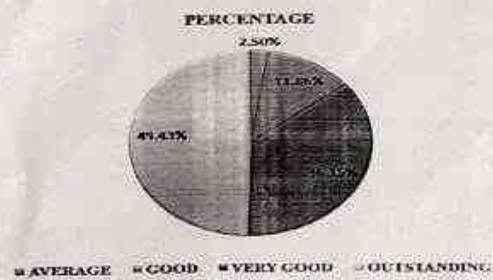

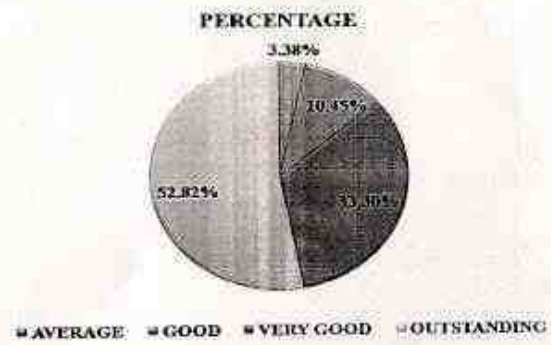

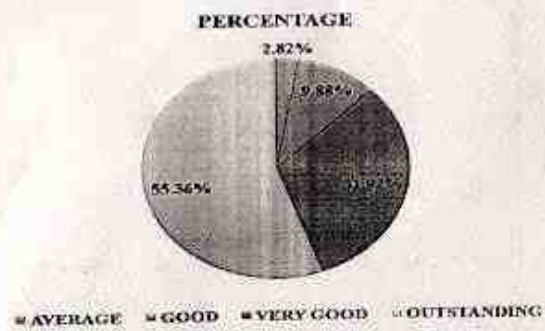

Teacher makes the subject/learning more interesting

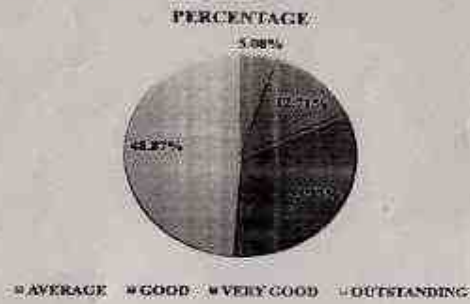

The teacher encourages the student to ask question

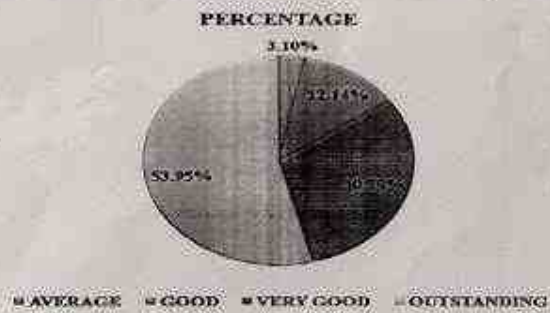

Interest/ motivation is generated by the teacher

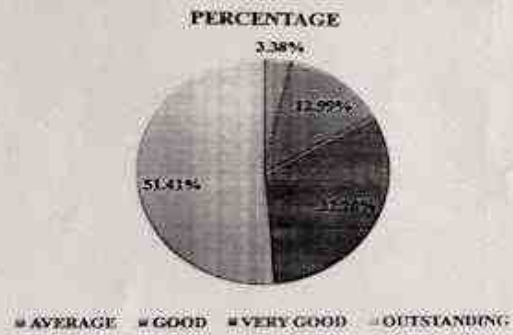

Overall rating about the teacher

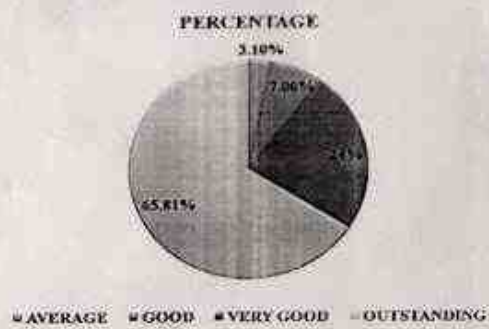

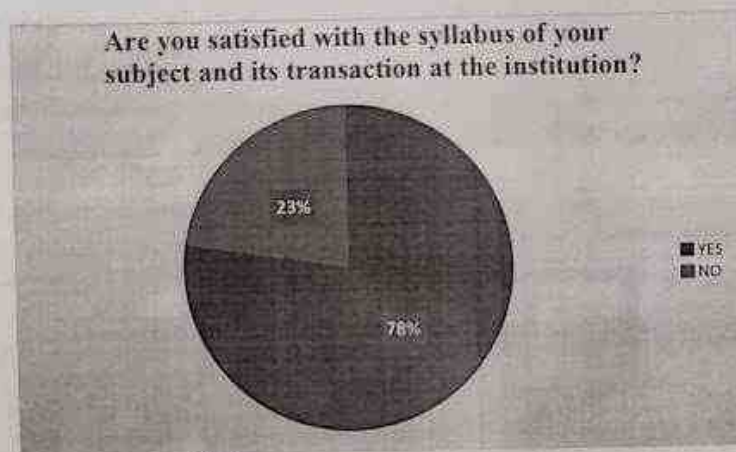

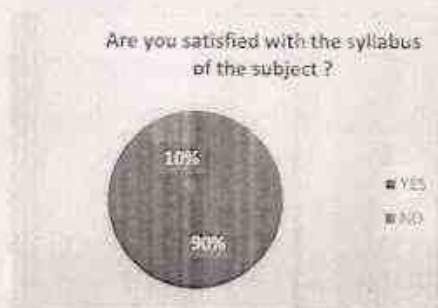

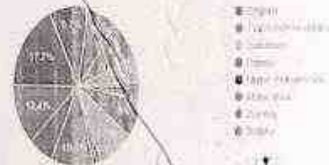

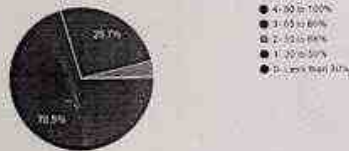

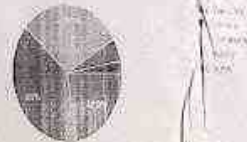

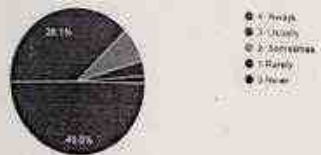

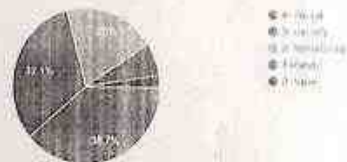

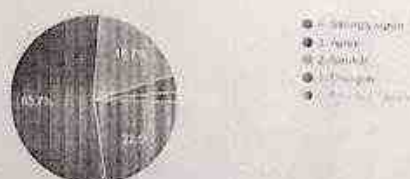

A total of about 76.5% students responded that overall teaching learning process was good in the college during the session (Fig. 12).

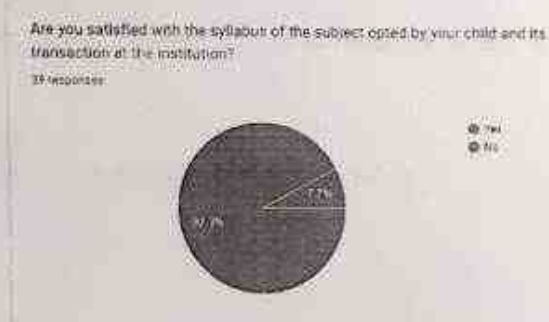

The survey included 315 responses from students of UG & PG classes including all the streams viz., B.A. (34.3%), B.Sc. (36.5%), M.A. (13%), M.Sc. (13.3%), B.Com. M.Com. and PGDCA (approx. 2.9%).

The Principal directed the faculty members to ensure that full syllabi is covered before final exams and should include various ICT tools like ppt, charts and video graphs so as to give better understanding and clarity of the subject matter.

In the feedback form, a total of 1159 students participated belonging to BA (43.4%), B.Sc. (29.4%), B.Com. (14.1%) and PG Classes (12.8%) as shown in Fig. 1. About 29.3% students were from first year, 53.1% from Second year and 17.5% from third year, as shown in Fig. 2.

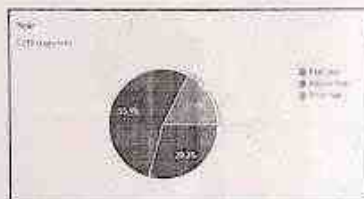

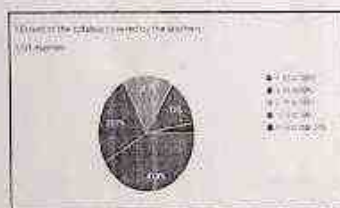

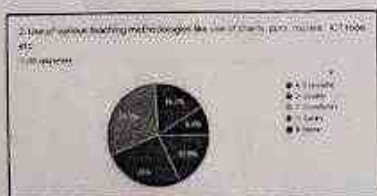

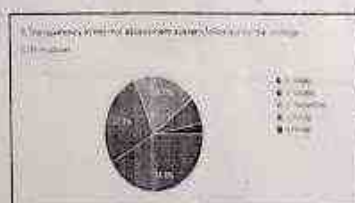

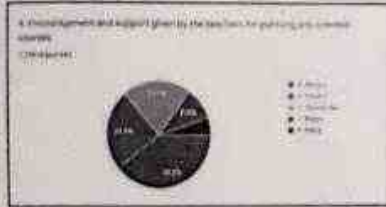

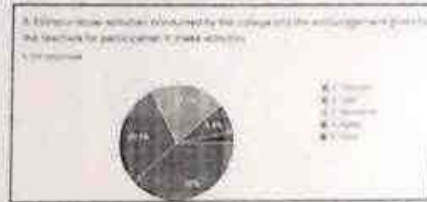

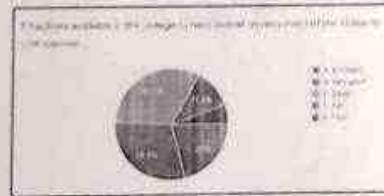

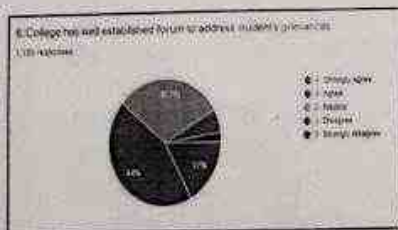

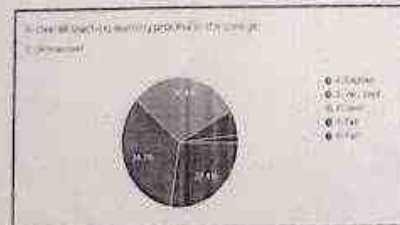

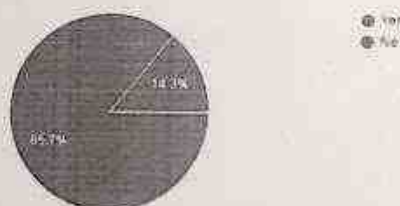

Action Taken Report

Action Taken Report on the basis of Students' Feedback (2020-21)

The feedback provided by the outgoing students vide google forms was analysed by the IQAC. It was identified that the requirements were related to infrastructure as well as academics. Some of the requirements and grievances of the students did not fall in the purview of the college jurisdiction, such as deficiency of teaching staff, provision of five day week and syllabi related requirements. However the faculty members who are a part of the Board of Studies of Panjab University will communicate to the University the changes proposed by the students in the subsequent meetings. The college authorities after layout by IQAC took the following measures:

- During the Covid-19 Pandemic, when the classes were being held in an offline mode the digital medium played a major role in academics. Keeping the welfare of the students in top most priority the college took sufficient measures for strengthening the digital infrastructure. The internet speed was increased to 100 Mbps; Printers and UPS were purchased for streamlining the e-teaching and e-learning facilities.
- Renovation of Washrooms was got done in order to ensure cleanliness round the clock.
- Labs were renovated and upgraded for better conduct of practical curriculum and research.
- Proposal for Multimedia Room and Research Centre was finalised.
- Servicing of water purifiers was got done for a clean, healthy environment.
- Lifts for Divyangjan became functional for easier mobility across the floors of the campus.
- In view of the online classes to be taken during the Pandemic, the Principal encouraged the faculty to be aware of the latest methodology towards e-teaching skills and prepare study material in the form of demonstrative PPTs, Video Lectures and recordings.
- The Principal also motivated the faculty to interact with students in an online mode on an informal platform so that they could take part in de-stress activities and talk more openly during the Pandemic.
- For engagement of students and faculty in interactive activities, webinars and online talks were organised wherein professionals, scholars and researchers updated the knowledge through their presentations and demonstrations.
- The students were also engaged in various community centric activities wherein they prepared presentations, videos and picture messages for awareness generation and sensitisation on issues related to Pandemic.

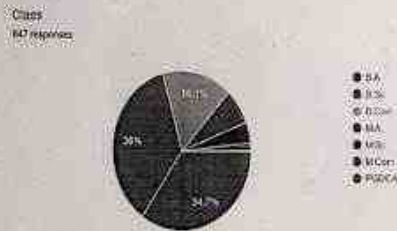

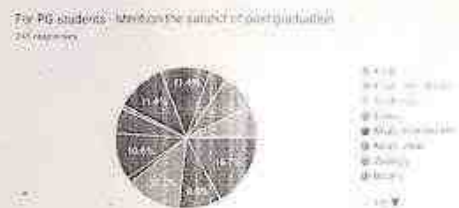

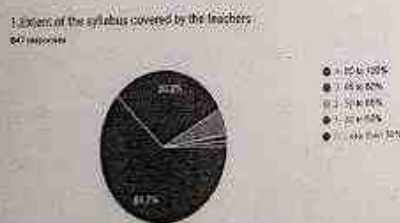

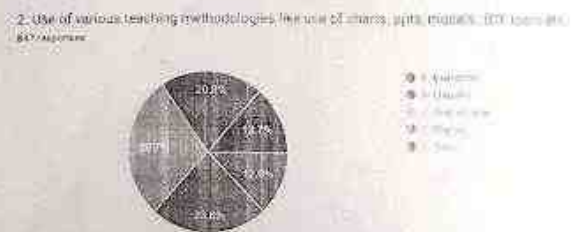

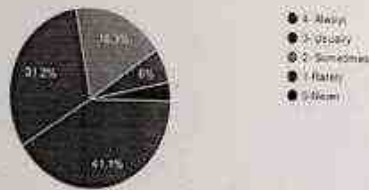

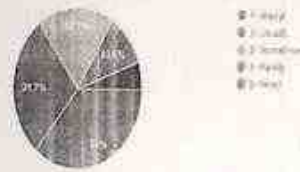

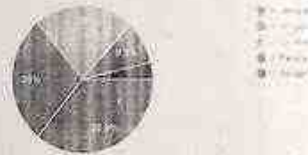

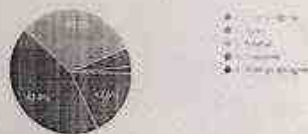

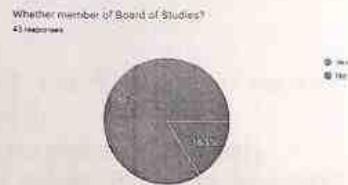

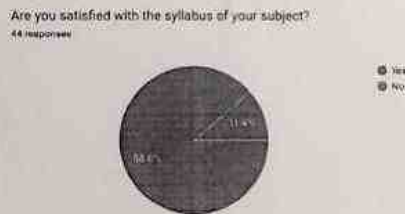
