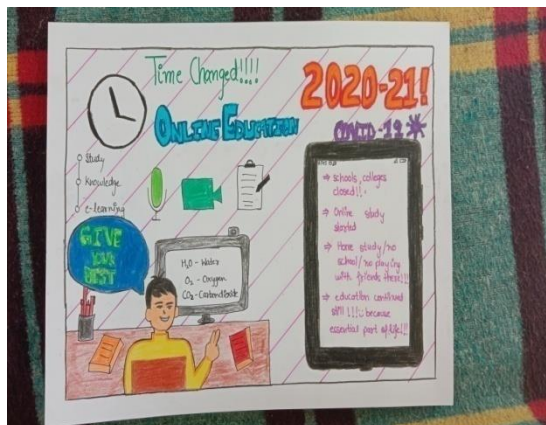

The focus of ongoing discussion was on the extent to which the Indian labour market is unorganized and the impact of COVID-19 lockdown.

Intra Class Competition of Commerce Department (Online)

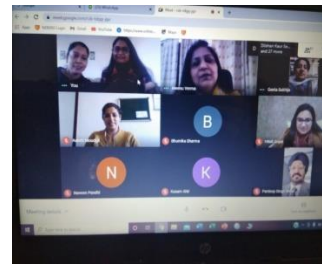

Poster-making and Slogan Writing entries by the students

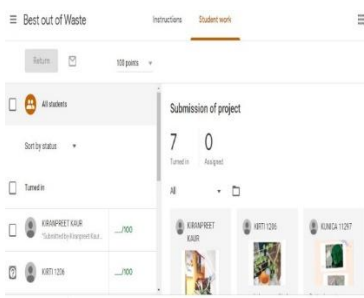
TALK Journey to success

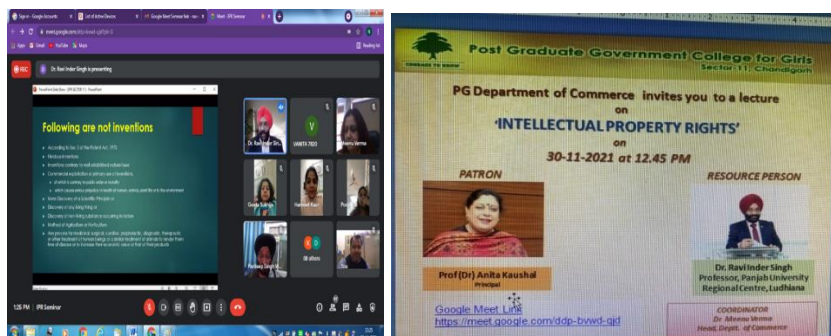
