As we resumed classroom teaching after a hiatus of two years, we diligently ensured the conduct of all curricular and co-curricular activities involving a creative interaction between the students and the faculty.

COLLEGE LIBRARY

- PGGCG-11 was the first College in Chandigarh to introduce RFID (Radio Frequency Identification) system which is a wireless system comprising Tags and Readers. It includes a self-service KIOSK and an Anti-theft Detection system. Installation of the RFID System has made the functioning of the library smooth and user-friendly, and has reinforced the security of literature. CCTV cameras have also been installed in the library.
- College library is fully computerized and air-conditioned, comprising a Reading Hall, a Circulation Section, Reference Section, Periodical Section, and Research Faculty Centre for staff to access e-books, e-journals, e-contents, and other information.
- It is equipped with RFID, LIBSYS Software, a free internet facility, INFLIBNIT, and an LCD that displays new arrivals and current affairs.
- All the students of the college can access the library. At the beginning of the academic session, first-year students are given a special Library Orientation Programme, where they are apprised about the rules and regulations of the library.
- All students are issued the library card, which they use for issuing books, journals, and magazines.
- In addition to the reading resources in English medium, it also has a rich collection of books in Hindi, Punjabi, Sanskrit, as well as French.

- Special consideration is given to *Divyangjan* in our institution. The library has JAWS software, zoom scanner and magnifier, braille sheets, daisy players and Hindi OCR software, and eCclipse writer converter software, to help *Divyang Jan* in their academic pursuits.
- Free books and stationery worth rupees eighty thousand are annually distributed among the students belonging to the underprivileged sections of society. Needy and meritorious students can also get textbooks issued for the entire academic session.
- The college Library has institutional membership of the National Digital Library of India (NDLI). Through this, both faculty and students can access the latest reference/academic material for learning, teaching, and research. The Library Blog 'PGGCG11LIBRARY' regularly uploads and updates library activities. It provides access to open resources via online links.
- The OPAC provides the facility to access the bibliographic database similar to the printed indexes. It provides the present status of books to the users, and they can also reserve a copy in case it is not available at that time.
- Web-OPAC provides an advanced graphical user interface to enable the search of the library database. It enables the users to check the availability of books online 24X7.
- The weekly planners, e-content, news clippings of college coverage in daily newspapers, syllabus, previous years' question papers, Honors class results, etc. are also maintained in the Library.

- The library also has an Alumni Desk where old students of the college are registered in the Alumni Association- Nostalgia.
- The library also maintains a record of the results of all the courses and issues Character Certificates and old Degrees to the college students.

COLLEGE MAGAZINE

Abha, the college magazine, showcases in pictorial form the achievements of the college and also provides a forum for the students to express their creativity on a wide range of issues in English, Hindi and Punjabi.

ORIENTATION ASSEMBLY

To acquaint new students with the college environment an orientation assembly is organised at the start of every academic session. The Principal, Prof. Anita Kaushal welcomes the students and highlights the curricular and co-curricular aspects as well as the rules and regulations of the college. Information is also imparted regarding time-tables, exams, college societies, library and scholarships available, so that the transition from school to college is smooth. This year the orientation was held on **29th August, 2022** in the college ground.

TUTORIAL MEET

Tutorial meets are planned twice a month on alternative Saturdays. Each tutor is assigned 25-35 students to familiarise them with the general discipline, rules and regulations. The students are also apprised of the Prevention of Ragging Committee and Sexual Harassment Complaint Centre. - **Tutorial held on 10th September, 2022**

On 10th September, 2022, The Traffic Awareness and Road Safety Society of PG Govt College for Girls-11, Chandigarh, in collaboration with SPICMACAY, organized an Interactive Session with the founder of SPICMACAY, Dr. Kiran Seth, Padam Shree awardee, an eminent academician and philanthropist.

The event was part of his Solo Cycle-Yatra mission from Kashmir to Kanyakumari. Dr. Seth shared with the students his three goals of **Physical Fitness, Environment Safety** and **Simple Living** as part of this yatra. He familiarized the students with the youth-oriented movement, SPICMACAY and its vision of bringing the youth of the country together in the understanding, practicing and promotion of Indian cultural heritage. The session ended with a very engaging interaction of Dr. Seth with the students wherein they participated enthusiastically.

In continuation of the above the Traffic Awareness and Road Safety Society also held an orientation programme for all the first-year students of the college. The students were sensitized towards safety on roads and the awareness of traffic rules that ensure it. They were asked to wear helmets while riding two wheelers and they should follow traffic rules. A discussion on activities as part of the society's agenda was also conveyed to the students. Relevant literature and flyers were also distributed to them. More than 450 students attended the programme. Principal, Prof (Dr) Anita Kaushal congratulated the members of the Traffic Awareness and Road Safety Society for organizing such a fruitful interactive session. She cautioned the students to follow Traffic rules as there is an increasing trend of mishaps due to unsafe driving.

- **Interactive session on Tips on Women Safety and Understanding Posh Act on 29th September 2022**

Student Welfare, Redressal of Grievances, Sexual Harassment of Women and Legal Awareness Committee of the Post Graduate Government College for Girls, Sector -11, Chandigarh organised an interactive session on, 'Tips on Women Safety and Understanding Posh Act' on 29th Sept' 2022 in the college auditorium. This session was conducted by the Women and Child Support Unit, Chandigarh Police.

Ms. Sita Devi, DSP, Women and Child Support Unit was the guest of honour. She apprised the participants comprising the students and the faculty members of the college about the preventive measures women can adopt in everyday life to ensure their safety. She explained The Sexual Harassment Of Women At Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 in detail. Her presentation was insightful and engaging. Citing the examples of the cases dealt by her in Chandigarh, she elaborated the nuances of the law and kept the audience engaged. She emphasised on the importance of having a supportive and conducive

environment at the workplace where students and women employees feel safe and confident about reporting the case of abuse.

Team Swayam (self - defence unit of Women and Child Support Unit) demonstrated the techniques of self - defence that women can practice in the situation of crises. They enacted the situations where women are often targeted and demonstrated the techniques that can help catch the perpetrators at the site of crime.

The concluding segment of the programme was on the safety of women from cybercrimes. Ms. Garima, volunteer with cybercrime police, Chandigarh talked about the various types of cybercrimes happening in the present times. She emphasized on the preventive measures that can be taken in order to save oneself from these crimes. Quoting the cases dealt by the cyber cell, Chandigarh, she explained how women are more vulnerable to these crimes and the importance of being vigilant while using the internet and mobile phones. She also shared the helpline numbers and the web links where one can report these cases.

Overall, the event was a success. Participants understood the law and the mechanism of grievance redressal and the process to lodge the complaint in the event of sexual harassment at workplace.

Under the dynamic leadership and guidance of Principal Prof. (Dr.) Anita Kaushal, Pink Ribbon Society & Community Hygiene and Public Health Society in Collaboration with Department of Zoology of Post Graduate Government College for Girls, Sector 11 organized a Seminar under “Rani Breast Cancer Awareness Campaign” on 08.10.2022 in the College campus to spread awareness on Breast Cancer. Present in the occasion was Principal of college Prof. (Dr) Anita Kaushal and senior faculty members of the college.

The Speaker of the Seminar was Ms. Bittu Safeena Sandhu, Managing trustee of “Rani Breast Cancer Trust.” She herself is Cancer Survivor. About 50 student members of the Society participated in Seminar in which they explained how

Cancer spreads and what are the precautionary measures to avoid Cancer from spreading & how early detection of cancer can be a key to protection.

Ms. Ritika, Member of the Society thanked Guest for Spreading awareness among faculty members and students as how we can protect our life with early detection of Breast Cancer.

This Seminar proved to be a source of awareness to faculty and students of the college.

- **Pariksha Pe Charcha 27th January, 2023**

PG Govt. College for Girls, Sector-11, Chandigarh streamed the live telecast of “Pariksha Pe Charcha” on 27th January, 2023. It is an annual event in which the Hon’ble Prime Minister interacts with the students appearing in exams across the length and breadth of the country. Post Graduate Govt. College Sector-11, Chandigarh organized a tutorial meet in association with Community Hygiene and Public Health Society and Department of Zoology on the topic “Fighting Breast Cancer” on 7th Feb.,2023. The speaker was Miss Bittu Safeena Sandhu, Managing Trustee, Rani Breast Cancer Trust. Miss Sandhu highlighted the need to have regular mammography for all the ladies above 50 years to have early detection of any signs of breast cancer. She advised all the students present to have the mammography done for their mothers free of cost by Rani Breast Cancer Trust. She also demonstrated the technique of regular self-evaluation for lump detection if any. Rani Breast Cancer Trust also displayed the craft articles prepared by cancer survivors for charity. Principal Madam Prof. (Dr) Anita Kaushal, faculty members and around 300 graduation students attended he talk.

INFRASTRUCTURE

The college has a host of amenities to make the academic journey of its students comfortable and congenial.

- Thirty-Five-acre campus with a total constructed area of 58116 Sq.m, dotted with 4000 trees, 15 lush green lawns, and three gardens: - *Botanical Garden*, a *Herbal Garden*, *Solace Garden* along with a *Green House* and pergolas which provide the campus an eye-pleasing green camouflage and provide an ideal ambience for **scholarly and extracurricular pursuits**.
- Spacious, ventilated classrooms/lecture rooms, of which 42 are smart classrooms with multimedia projection facilities, digital podiums, interactive boards, and internet facilities. We have fully an air-conditioned Academic and Administrative Block. **Seminar and Conference rooms** equipped with latest technology.
- Well-equipped labs for Botany, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology (separate labs for UG/PG classes), Information Technology, Psychology, Geography, Home

Science, Fine Arts, Functional English, and Functional Hindi, five computer labs for BCA, B.Sc (Computer Science) and M.SC. (IT).

- A Research Centre for Ph.D. courses, a Multi-Media Room, an Innovation Cell, Central Instrumentation Centre, Skill Development Lab, Solution preparation Room, Museum, Dark room, air-conditioned Seminar Room /Conference Room for various academic activities. All 28 departments have been provided with a desktop computer and printer.
- A **Skill Development Lab** equipped with 17 computers and internet.
- PGGCG-11 is a Green College with solar panels generating 495 KWp, and the first college in the city to have Windrow Composting System for solid waste management.
- Fully air-conditioned, computerized Library equipped with LIBSYS Software, RFID system, free internet facility, INFLIBNIT, Faculty Research Center, LCD displaying new arrivals, institutional membership of the National Digital Library of India (NDLI) and Web-OPAC to check the availability of books online. The Library Blog gives access to open resources via the online links.
- For Divyangjan we provide JAWS talking software, braille sheets, Daisy Players, Zoom Scanner/Reader cum magnifier software, Hindi OCR software, eClipse writer converter software in the library. The college has elevators, ramps, provision of wheelchairs, and a separate toilet for the Divyangjan.
- The four hostels with excellent ambiance and other amenities accommodate students not just from all over our country but many students from off-shores too. There is a reading room, recreation room, yoga room, and medical room with 24x7 availability of a qualified nurse. **Water boosting storage** installed for the hostels wherein **50,000 litres of water** can be stored.
- College offers state-of-the-art training equipment, Indoor Badminton Hall, Table Tennis Hall, Yoga Centre, Basket Ball court, and a multi-purpose ground for track/field events, an air-conditioned indoor gymnasium, and open-air gyms to nurture many state, national and international level sportswomen of the college.
- A Four hundred seat auditorium along with specialized rooms/departments that facilitates students to polish their co-curricular skills in music, singing dance,

theatre, and oratorical events. The college also has open air stage to host various cultural and performance activities.

- ‘Cozy Cove’- a recreational centre for students comprises an air-conditioned common room for students, with Wi-Fi, LED, home theatre, board games, and Table Tennis.
- ‘Shopping Arcade’- a place where the basic needs of students and teachers are met houses a tailor shop, a Health Salon, ATM, Photostat, STD/mobile, stationary, cobbler Post-box and a tuck shop.
- College canteen, along with Nescafe kiosk, Fruit/Juice stall, and chat corner, offer healthy hygienic food.
- The college has a fully equipped air conditioned creche for the convenience of the faculty.
- Air-Conditioned Central Instrumentation Centre.
- **24*7 CCTV** surveillance to ensure safety and security.
- The Rain Water Harvesting System for the purpose of preserving water.
- **Vermi-composting system** to convert organic matter into humus using worms and micro-organisms.
- Latest fire safety equipment has also been installed on the campus.
- A hooter alarm system has been installed for emergency use.

I.T. Infrastructure:

- We believe in an amalgamation of progressive ideas, innovative tools, and perseverance that leads to a never-ending quest for excellence. This zeal is supplemented by 35 smart classrooms with multimedia projection facilities, digital podiums, interactive boards, and internet facilities on the campus. Internet, as we know, is constantly evolving and offering flexibility to users. This has in turn encouraged educational institutions to step forward and setup secured and stable wired or Wi-Fi networks on campuses for their students.
- To make the learning process stimulating and inspiring, our college provides a state-of-the-art IT network in laboratories for Botany, Chemistry, Zoology, Fine Arts, Computer Application, Functional English, Geography, Psychology, Home

Science and Performing Arts. In an endeavour to fulfill the mission of providing all-around comprehensive knowledge, exclusive Information Technology Blocks with cutting-edge facilities like sophisticated computer labs, Leased-line/Broadband internet connectivity and IT integrated pedagogy, etc. are being provided to students and staff.

- We have an Innovation Cell by Government of India, Skill Development Lab, Central Instrumentation Centre, Research Centre, Seminar Room, Conference Room, and Auditorium, all equipped with IT-enabled apparatuses.
- The newly constructed Multimedia room and Research block are equipped with cutting edge technology, to enable students to hone their skills and be proficient in project works, professional endeavours, and co-curricular activities.
- The college was using a leased line of 10 Mbps since 2015. During the unprecedented times of COVID-19, all classes were being held online. All the academic work and most of the administrative work, such as filling application forms, scrutiny of forms, admissions, and payment of fees was done online. To meet this new surge in internet traffic and smoothen its functioning, **the college upgraded the lease line from 10 Mbps to 100 Mbps.**
- The college subscribed to Google Suite (educational), comprising Google Classroom and Google Meet, and many other tools to ease the increased online teaching workload. This also helped both teachers and students in conducting/participating in numerous online activities like workshops and webinars, etc.
- The college provides round-the-clock Wi-Fi facility to Staff and students on campus, as well as in all four hostels. To access the internet connection in the college, students are provided with browsing centers in the Library, Cosy Cove (Common Room cum Recreational Center), and hostels. This helps students to avail facilities of e-mail, net surfing, and up/down loading of web-based applications, besides preparing projects, presentations, and seminars. Bandwidth for different types of the users is set according to the need of the user.
- The College has more than 340(345) computers, with printing and scanning facilities, for academics, library, and administrative work. The college has

distributed more than Eighty Laptops to the faculty members for streamlining and enhancing academic and administrative tasks.

- The college is using server management software such as NEBERO to prevent illegal access to the internet. As a safeguard against illegal and malicious activities on the internet, the college is providing different logins with different levels of policies, for staff as well as students. Such activities on the internet can be monitored with Nebero, which is a premier service provider for network security systems.

SAARTHI (Counselling Cell in the Dept. of Psychology)

- On **10th September 2022, Awareness of Suicide Prevention Day** - In order to educate students about suicide prevention and warn about warning signs, an awareness drive was carried out. For this, a poetry competition on the theme of “Creating Hope” and an Essay writing competition on “13 reasons why I live!” were also organized.
- On **10th October 2022**, The Department of Psychology and SAARTHI - the Counselling Cell of PGGCG-11, along with ‘Zehnat’ - an NGO, organised to celebrate "**World Mental Health Day**" on the college campus.
Students of Psychology Department organized a Mental Health camp where various psychological, mental health and well-being scales were administered on students and accordingly students were informed about their mental-health and well-being
- On **2nd March 2023**, Psychological Testing – How Have You Been? – the Post Graduate students of the Psychology Department mobilized the workshop of psychological tests and intervention activities for the college students with the twin aim of nurturing their mental health as well for their well-being.
- Aesthetic Artist – **Art Therapy** – was another activity organized by the PG students on **2nd March 2023**. They applied art therapy which was based on environmental psychology theme of the Zeitgeist, portraying students’ knowledge of flora-fauna and their surroundings.

Alumni Meet is organised twice a year that gives an opportunity to our students to improve upon themselves through the enriching experiences of our worthy alumnae. The association releases an annual newsletter that appraises our alumnae and students of the activities organized throughout the year.
