Dr. Manjeet Singh Trehan, Additional Director-Internal Medicine Fortis MedCentre, Chandigarh was the speaker of the event. He interacted with the students and enlightened them about the importance of proper diet and exercise to reduce the risk of obesity. He also highlighted various diseases that can be caused due to obesity. Around 85 graduate and post graduate students enthusiastically participated in the talk.

4. Lecture on 'Nutrition during Mensuration and Menstrual Hygiene' and Health Club Activity 22nd Sept. 2022

Under the able guidance of our worthy Principal ma'am, Prof. (Dr.) Anita Kaushal, PGGCG – 11, Chandigarh organized health and activity club for adolescent girls to celebrate 5th Rashtriya Poshan Maah (National Nutrition Month, 2022). In the activity, a lecture was delivered by Dr. Ravneet Kaur, Assistant Professor in Zoology, PGGCG-11, Chandigarh on topic **'Nutrition during Mensuration and Menstrual Hygiene'** on 22^{nd} September, 2022. The speaker focused on the complementary relationship between the food we eat and our menstrual cycle. The discussion included the Art To Eat Smart that maintains the fitness level, mental state as well as optimum levels of nutrients and hormones in the body that helps to have a painless and regular period. The students were sensitized about healthy eating patterns to prevent immediate health problems, such as iron deficiency, anaemia, obesity, eating disorders, heart disease, cancer, and stroke. The lecture also gave a brief review about the role of healthy eating habits and regular physical activity to manage PCOS.

A health club was also formed by four students of M.Sc. II Zoology, namely, Ms. Devyani, Ms. Shreya, Ms. Deepti, Ms. Rishita who interacted with the students about the importance of Menstrual Health and Hygiene for the well-being and empowerment of women and adolescent girls. About 100 students interacted with the health club members and the speaker and discussed their routine problems and queries with them.
