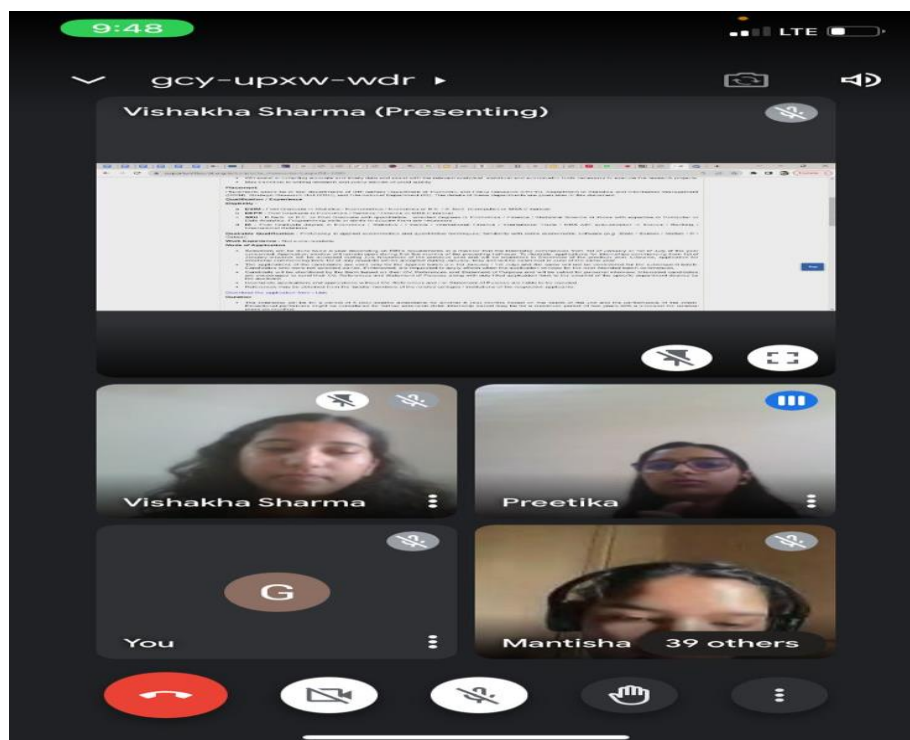


Nostalgia- The Alumni Association of College

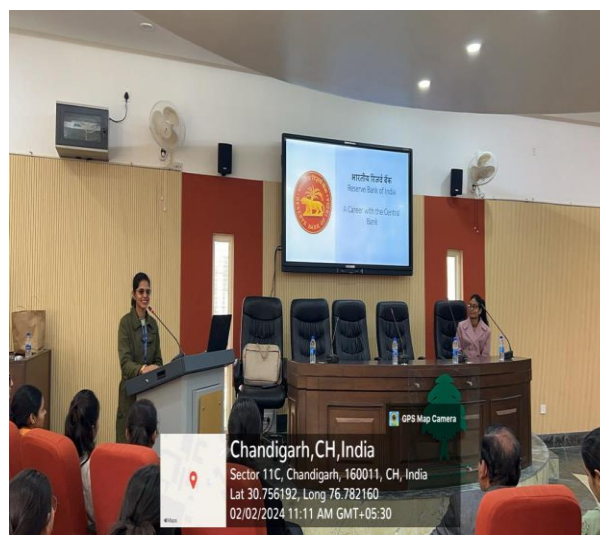
Open House Discussion
