Traffic Awareness and Road Safety Society under the aegis of IQAC in collaboration with Department of Public Administration organized a talk on “Drive Safe Stay Smart” which was presented by Wg Cdr CS Grewal on 10th February 2024. The programme started with the welcome address and a brief introduction of Wg Cdr CS Grewal who had also been a Chief Traffic Marshal in Chandigarh Traffic Police since 2004. More than 300 under graduates of all streams attended the presentation.

The Chief Traffic Marshal appraised the students present about the rules and regulations on road safety. He also played some videos showing serious road accident and their cause. The rate of road accident in India has risen manifold whereas other countries have managed to control it. He expressed that heavy penalties for traffic violations are not the solution. People need to be made aware of the dire consequences if a vehicle is being driven without insurance or other valid documents. In the end, an interaction was held with the students and few questions were asked to be them for which they were rewarded. Finally, literature regarding road safety was distributed to the students. Mr. Ajay Kumar Sharma felicitated the guest with a token of Appreciation also.
