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ANALYSIS OF STUDENT FEEDBACK

(2023 – 2024)

In the feedback form, a total of 847 students participated belonging to B. Com (21.5%), B.Sc.(6%), BA and PG Classes (72.4%) as shown in Fig. 1. About 43.1% students were from first year, 36.8% from Second year and 20.1% from third year, as shown in Fig. 2.

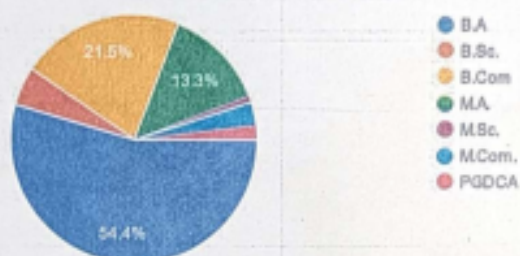

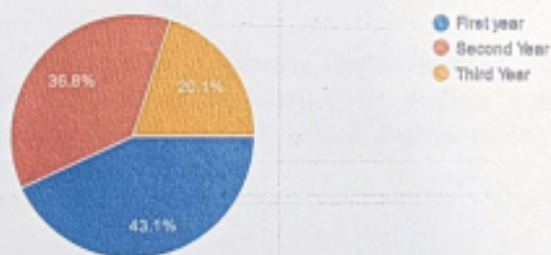

The following PG students participated in the feedback Performa, as shown in Fig. 3. In the First question regarding the extent of syllabus covered by the teachers, 97.3% students responded were of the opinion that more than 50% syllabus was covered. About 3% students were of the opinion that less than 30% syllabuses were covered (Fig. 4).

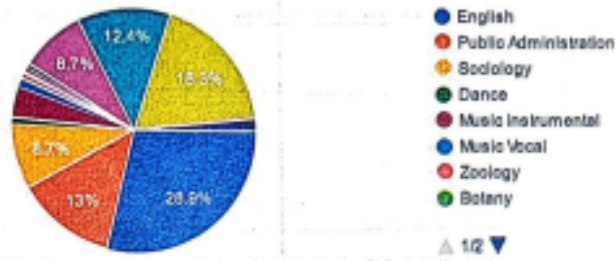

847 responses

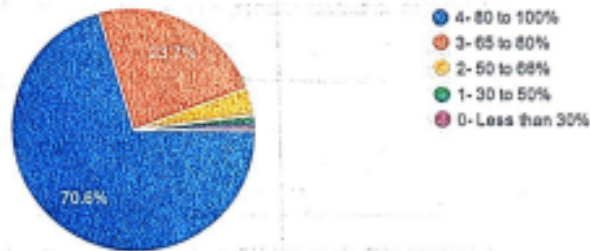

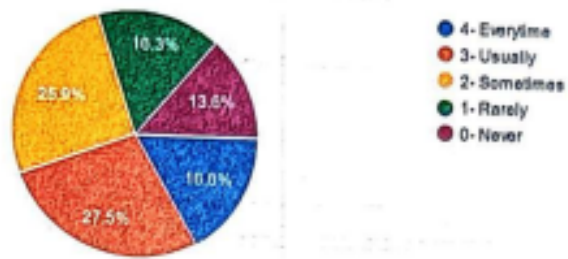

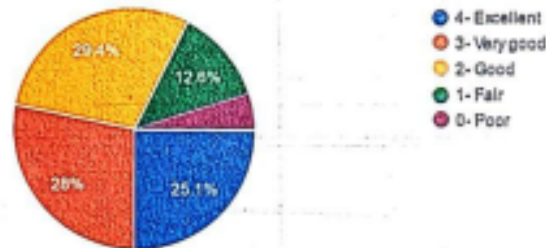

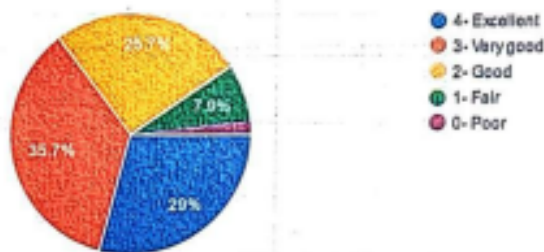

Action Taken Report on the Basis of Students' Feedback (2023 – 2024)

The principal called a staff meeting to discuss various issues raised by the students in the feedback form of session 2023-2024.

- On the demand of students, the library timings were increased by one hour.
- The Principal directed all the faculty members to be punctual and asked them not to miss their classes so that 100% syllabus can be completed on time.
- Teachers were directed to make themselves available for the students during their free periods so as to clear the doubts of the students and take remedial classes whenever necessary.
- The principal also advised the faculty members who are members of board of studies of the affiliating university to convey the need to upgrade curriculum to meet the need of the industry and service sector.
- The faculty was also encouraged to prepare study material in the form of descriptive PPT'S, video lectures, and recordings and upload on the college website to improve the teaching skills.
- The faculty members were directed to complete the practical syllabus in time so as to avoid the loss of students.
- The Principal also encouraged all the staff members to conduct more outreach activities, national/International day celebrations and cultural activities for better results and holistic development.
- The faculty members were asked to motivate and nurture the curiosity of the students by organizing more expertise lectures, educational tours, field visits, seminars and workshops.
- College library was instructed to subscribe research journals, books and magazines so as to improve the understanding of the basics of the subjects with latest advances.
- About students stated that teachers were cooperative in the class. The Principal advised the staff members to be more polite and cooperative with students and provide them counselling whenever required.
- The members of IQAC committee directed all the faculty members to prepare their weekly planners so as to make students aware about the syllabus to be covered in the succeeding weeks.
- Teachers were directed to inform students about placement drives conducted in the college, various competitive examinations and highlight other job opportunities for their holistic development.
- The Principal directed the care taker of the college to arrange servicing of the water purification system of water coolers so as to ensure clean drinking water for the students.
- The cleanliness committee was also instructed to take regular rounds in order to ensure the cleanliness of the college campus.
- Regarding the repair of Auditorium, several letters have been sent to the engineering department & the work is in progress.

ANALYSIS OF ALUMNAE FEEDBACK FORM

2023 – 2024

The survey included 894 responses from alumnae of the college of session 2023-2024. About 97.8% participants responded positively about the syllabi of the subjects and its transaction at the institution. (Fig. 1). Around 8% alumnae are employed. About 52.6% respondents are also doing higher studies in various institutions (Fig. 2, 3). Some of the students also suggested the following additions to improve the syllabi.

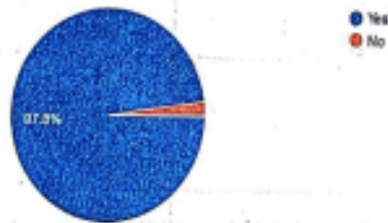

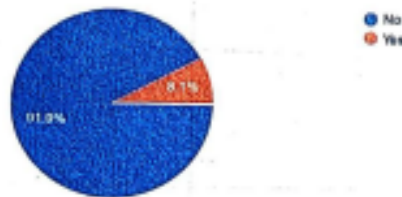

ANALYSIS OF FACULTY FEEDBACK

(2023 – 2024)

In the feedback form, 44.3% regular and 55.7% contractual faculty members participated, out of which approximately 16.5% are member board of studies of UG & PG classes (Fig. 1,2,3). The feedback showed that 82.3% faculty were satisfied with the syllabus and its transaction at the institution (Fig. 4). Some of the faculty members suggested that following additions may be done to improve the syllabi.

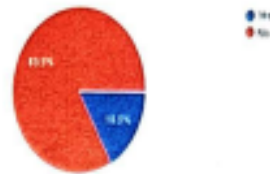

Members

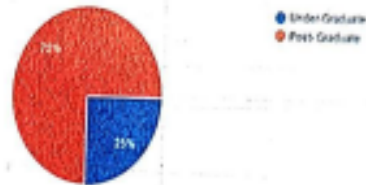
